I-81 to Exit 57 (PA Route 114); proceed north on Route 114 approximately 1 mile. At the signal light at the intersection of Routes 114 and 944 (Wertzville Road) go straight, take the second right past the signal turn in the lot. - Elements are divided into Levels "N"- "E" and further divided into "A" and "B" sections depending on the experience of the dog and/or handler. Be sure to check the rules regarding the divisions. For these classes, dogs will only be searching the elements chosen.
- Handler Discrimination. In Novice, Advanced, and Excellent, one glove must be provided by the handler. In Master level classes a personal item according to the rules for this level.
- All entries must be submitted on the current "Official UKC® Nosework Trial Entry Form".
- Use a separate entry form for each dog entered in a club's event.
- Nosework events are open to all UKC registered breeds and mixed-breed dogs with a valid Performance Listing/Limited Privilege number/Permanent Registration/Temporary Listing.
- We want you to keep the points earned at UKC Licensed events. Important things to remember:
 - All dogs entering UKC events must be permanently registered, have a valid Temporary Listing Number, or a Performance Listing/Limited Privilege number.
 - Dog not UKC registered? Apply for a Temporary Listing Number (TL) online at www.ukcdogs.com/tl-numbers. (TL fees are non-refundable, non-transferable and do not apply to the cost of permanent registration.)
 - All entry forms must be completed and signed. Incorrect information submitted on the entry form may invalidate your wins.
